#### **How Mother's Day Began**

Anna M. Jarvis (1964-1948) first suggested the national observance of an annual day honoring all mothers, because she loved her own mother so dearly. At a memorial service for her mother on May 10, 1908, Miss Jarvis gave a carnation (her mother's favorite flower) to each person who attended. On May 9, 1014 by an act of congress, President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed the second Sunday in May as "Mother's Day". He established the day as a time for "public expression of our love and reverence for the mothers of our country."
