## HOW MOTHER'S DAY BEGAN.....

Anna M. Jarvis (1864-1948) first suggested the national observance of an annual day honoring all mothers, because she loved her own mother so dearly. At a memorial service for her mother on May 10, 1908, Miss Jarvis gave a carnation (her mother's favorite flower) to each person who attended. On May 9, 1914 by an act of congress, President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed the second Sunday in May as "Mother's Day". He established the day as a time for "public expression of our love and reverence for the mothers of our country."

Originally known as Decoration Day, it originated in the years following the Civil War and became an official federal holiday in 1971. Many Americans observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries or memorials, holding family gatherings and participating in parades.
