Break Old Patterns

“But Jesus said unto him, Follow Me; and let the dead bury their dead.” Matthew 8:22

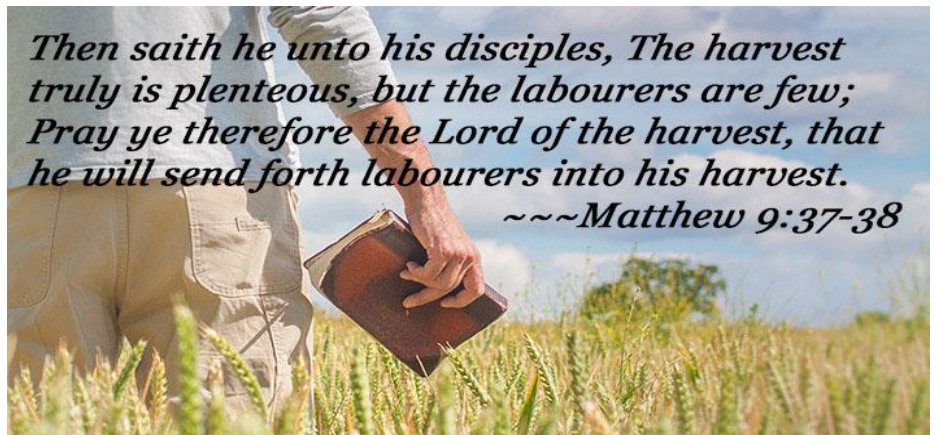
